



## Your interest in the university course to become a

### Certified Canine Rehabilitation Practitioner (CCRP) – FAST-TRACK -

Thank you for your interest in the CCRP course 2014. This highly accredited qualification requires the completion of Part I - V (Fast-track) CCRP course, 40 hours externship and documentation of 5 clinical cases. To earn the title CCRP you finally have to participate in the exams, which are offered twice a year in Europe, additionally in South Africa and the USA.

#### ***What to expect***

The course consists of e-learning and presence days followed by an externship, case reports and finally the exams. Please find attached the brochure with all details for your interest.

The e-learning part covers all lectures of Part I, II and III and needs to be finished before the presence days. We recommend to start the e-learning part as early as possible as it is quite demanding, providing you the necessary back ground needed for the presence days. You will receive your access code for the e-learning part as soon as you are registered and at least a down payment arrived into our account. This access is open for 3 years (!) which allows you to reflect these topics again before you come for the exams.

During the presence days we focus on labs and only offer short summaries of key points instead of heavy lectures for all topics of Part I - III. As we all stay at the same place (including the speakers of course) there is a lot of opportunity to further discuss open questions beyond the course hours. This makes this education so effective. So the first 3 days are mainly labs. Followed by part IV, where we work in small groups on cases, which than have to be presented and discussed. Another part, which is always highly appreciated. We finish the course with in depth interactive work on Osteoarthritis and Neurology.

Thus this course combines theoretical knowledge, evidence based with a high impact of recent research..We greatly appreciate the opportunity to use all different kind of equipment during our courses, which adds very valuable hands on experience. A lot of emphasis is put on teamwork also in terms of discussing rehab cases, experiences in different countries and with different material/units. The input of attendees from different countries on treatment plans is a great add on to the profound scientific background and practical experience of our world wide accredited speakers.
