Affectionately known as The White Palace, the hotel commands breathtaking views of the sea and the dramatic cliffs at Beachy Head. The Grand is a landmark on the Eastbourne seafront and stands out amongst other Eastbourne hotels being only a short walk from the Pier in one direction, and the glorious Sussex Downs in the other. The hotel is looking forward to welcoming the members of the BAHVS and their guests and we are also invited to stay on for live music and dancing after the celebration dinner there.

**Travel Arrangements** - Eastbourne has very good travel connections.

**Trains** ..... Hourly trains leave London Victoria directly to Eastbourne. Journey approximately 1½ hours. From the station the conference centre is 20 minutes walk or there are plenty of taxis just outside.

**Planes** ..... Gatwick is not far away. There are frequent trains directly to Eastbourne. Journey time around 1 hour. From Heathrow travel directly into London and then on to London Victoria by underground.

**and automobiles.** Parking. On-street parking. You can purchase a voucher from the venue reception desk for £1.00 (a special price), this lasts for 24 hours, parking in the 'S' zone which is the streets around the Centre. You can park for free if you park farther away in the streets off of the seafront.

### From M25 or from the A27

As an outline guide, from the M25, anticlockwise past Heathrow, exit to M23 at junction 7, following signs to Brighton, past Gatwick airport, follow onto A23 and turn off A23 at sign for Lewes (A27). Travel on A27 eastwards until Polegate, turn left and at next roundabout take third turning following the signs to Eastbourne and then signs for seafront. You will join the seafront at the Sovereign Centre swimming pool roundabout. Continue round the roundabout, taking the third exit onto the seafront. Continue along the seafront until the main bandstand (blue roof) is on the left and the Centre is 100yds on the right.

### An alternate route from the M25

Take the A22, through East Grinstead, across Ashdown Forest following the signs for Eastbourne until you reach the A27 roundabout. Take the first exit. Follow signs to Eastbourne and then signs for seafront. You will join the seafront at the Sovereign Centre swimming pool roundabout. Continue round the roundabout, taking the third exit onto the seafront. Continue along the seafront until the main bandstand (blue roof) is on the left and the Centre is 100yds on the right.



# Speakers for Conference 2012

## **Peter Gregory BVSc VetFFHom CertIAVH MRCVS**

Peter is well known to most members of the Association as a past president and he is also a long term teacher with the Homeopathic Professionals Teaching Group. He lectures to vets in the UK and several other countries, and has been practising veterinary homeopathy for many years. He works with Tim Couzens at the Holistic Veterinary Medicine Centre in East Sussex, and he also has a practice in Dorset. He is currently President of the IAVH. Peter's talk is:

“Sepia – a study in ageing” An investigation into Sepia as a homeopathic remedy, looking at how a remedy picture can change as the age of the patient increases.

## **Mark Moodie**

Mark Moodie is a self-employed researcher into potencies. He is the initiator of the Considera project which supplies potencies and collects and collates the results of their use on plants, soils and composts. He will be talking to us about the Considera project.

## **David Lilly FFHom**

David studied homeopathy initially under the tutelage of his father and then at the RLHH' becoming MFHom in 1965. He returned to South Africa in 1966 to join in his father's homeopathic and osteopathic practice in Pretoria. In 1994 he started the first homeopathic course for medical doctors in South Africa. David retired in 2007 after over 40 years in practice, to concentrate on teaching and writing. His talk will be on: “Silica the remedy” in David's unique style.

## **Atjo Westerhuis**

Atjo Westerhuis, vet.surgeon; almost 40 years companion animals practitioner including homoeopathy. Teacher homeopathy in the Netherlands and Germany. Co-founder and honorary member of the Dutch Group of Veterinary Homoeopaths. Co-founder of the IAVH. Author of “Your Dog and Homoeopathy”. Advisor of Vetined Veterinary Internet Education. Lecture: “High Value Veterinary Symptoms I learned in practice you don't find in Synthesis”.

## **Tom Farrington MVB VetMFHom MRCVS**

Tom has spent many years working with homeopathy. He has worked in large animal practice in Ireland, then small animal practice in London. After returning to Ireland, he worked in both mixed and small animal practice before moving from Dublin to cork to set up a practice with a primary focus on homeopathic treatment in all species.

His talk is entitled: “Sun, Sea & Sand...Remedy Relationships”. Remedies such as Calc Carb being related to Silicea marina, Sepia to Natrum marina, Cygnus cygnus. Fucus to Thyroidinum, Sol to x-rays with cases showing these relationships.

## **Trevor Gunn**

Trevor Gunn's talk combines an up-to-date science of infectious disease and immune function together with the often neglected perspective of holism, thereby illustrating the full impact of vaccines on living systems. Trevor's presentation does in fact demonstrate how a fuller understanding of the biological sciences, in both its reductionist detail and holistic overview, leads us to a new paradigm in medicine and consequently elucidates, new, more effective strategies for the prevention of serious illness.

## **Sue Armstrong MA VetMB VetMFHom, CertIAVH MRCVS RSHom**

Sue qualified from Cambridge University and worked in Oxford and then in partnership in Leeds until setting up her dream practice “Balanced Being” in Wetherby in 2003, with homeopathy as its core philosophy. Sue started studying homeopathy with the RLHH and went on to gain her VetMFHom in 1996 and RSHom in 2007 She is now a partner in HPTG (Homeopathic Professionals Teaching Group) with whom she lectures, and is also an international lecturer on homeopathy throughout the world. She is the recent Past President of the BAHVS. Her talk is entitled: “A Grain of Sand”
